Most of the printed material and correspondence of the early birth control movement are stored in 272 large containers in the Manuscript Division of the Library of Congress. Here, too, are Margaret Sanger's scrapbooks of clippings, personal letters, and bits of an erratically kept journal. The vast amount of later documents, along with more scrapbooks, letters, and jottings from all periods, as well as the files of *The Women Rebel* and *The Birth Control Review*, 1917-1928, are in the Sophia Smith Collection at Smith College.

Paramount to an understanding of Margaret Sanger's life are her own books, after which I list a few others.
